Over this past weekend, there was an article that came out from the Globe and Mail indicating that Health Canada has advised CEN Biotech of its intent to reject its application to become a LP under the MMPR and that they have 21 days to contact Health Canada to rectify the issue.

This prompted me to contact Health Canada to find out if this was really true because based on my knowledge of the process, the information shared between an applicant and Health Canada is confidential. I spoke to a lady named Chelsie from the Office of Medical Cannabis and she informed me that she had no knowledge of such a story. Chelsie also verified my research that no information between an applicant and Health Canada would be publicized and she would have to research this article in case someone like myself called with a similar inquiry.

Lastly, and most important, Chelsie provided me with your email address to contact your organization because she informed me that you guys approve and reject the applications. She couldn't answer this question; if an applicant like Cen Biotech who has gone through all steps of the process http://www.hc-sc.gc.ca/dhp-mps/marihuana/info/application_steps-etapes_lp-pa-eng.php and passed, can they still be rejected for any reason? Also, were you aware of the aforementioned Globe and Mail story? Finally, Cen Biotech has appealed to the OMB regarding a last minute zoning change by the town of Lakeshore. Does that have ANY influence over them to NOT receive their licence?

Dear Minister Ambrose,

It has come to my attention that the OSC is currently looking into CEN Biotech. While I respect your duty to investigate any circumstances that may seem warranted; I'd like to take this opportunity to bring to your attention the one-sided approach some media outlets and specifically author Grant Robertson has taken.

Since December 20th 2014, Grant Robertson has published 13 articles, equivalent to 1 every week. That seems like an unusually high amount and these articles have had a detrimental effect on the share price. While I respect the freedom of the press, this seems to be a little extreme and possibly a coordinated attack to negatively impact the company and its shareholders. Oddly enough, Grant Robertson seems to somehow be getting information from Health Canada before anyone else as evidenced by the leak of sensitive information to Grant Robertson. In all of Grant Robertson's articles he slanders the company and CEO Bill Chaaban, often making misleading statements and creating outright lies. In all of the articles I have read by Grant Robertson, he has yet to have one positive thing to say about the company. It has come to the point that I now expect a new bashing article by Grant Robertson every week, regurgitating the same misleading leading information over and over again to make the company look bad. It seems to be an attempt to attack the company and possibly manipulate the stock price. I have been a shareholder in this company for over a year. I have spent countless hours researching all aspects of the company including the application to Health Canada for a MMPR license, to the build out of the facility in Lakeshore, the Board of Directors established by CEO Bill Chaaban, and the inspection Health Canada made this past July. I am well aware that Mr. Chaaban has sold shares under SEC regulations (as Mr. Robertson brings up in all of his articles) to fund the company and I completely support that decision. Mr. Chaaban has been completely honest and transparent throughout the entire process and I stand behind him 100%.

If you truly want to investigate the company I encourage you to please look at all the other aspects that have tried to portray CEN Biotech in a negative light, from the town council of Lakeshore to Grant Robertson at the Globe and Mail. The town of Lakeshore willingly accepted Cen Biotech into their town and was proud to have them, which can evidently be seen in the welcoming press conference, only to try and retroactively change zoning of the property after the facility was already completed. Not only is that illegal, but it shows the complete flip-flopping from the town. The town council recently proposed a zoning by-law amendment in November, long after CEN Biotech's facility was already completed. The intended use of the facility has been well known for quite a while so it seems that CEN Biotech's facility should clearly have "legal non-conforming use" if the by-law even gets approved by the county.

As a shareholder in this company, I stand behind the actions of CEO Bill Chaaban and the entire company 100%. Mr. Chaaban has been completely transparent and honest throughout this entire process and that is why there are plenty of shareholders that support him and the company's actions. In your investigation I hope that you please look at all aspects of this situation with an unbiased approach.

To whom it may concern

It has been brought to my attention that Creative Edge Nutrition / Cen Biotech is under investigation by the SEC in conjunction with the OSC (Ontario Securities Commission). Please be advised that I am a shareholder of the above mentioned company and am deeply concerned that both security commissions have chosen to investigate this organization once again as the investigation appears to be misdirected.

Prior to investing, I have dedicated many hours of research and stay current on all issues pertaining to the company. Please note; I have reviewed Health Canada website pertaining to the licensing process. I have read all versions of the Lakeshore MMPR City by-laws. I have read the entire MMPR consolidated guidelines. I have read the Canada's Controlled Drug Act. I have read all press releases issued by the company. I have reviewed all company financial statements issued within the past year. I have read nearly every article published about the company. I have reviewed profile information regarding the CEO and officers involved with this company. I have read the facility inspection by health Canada. I have had dialog with an MMPR consultant. Therefore, I am comfortable with my due diligence conducted regarding Creative Edge Nutrition / Cen Biotech. As a result, I can make my next statement with personal certainty. Creative Edge Nutrition / Cen biotech has in **no way** misled me regarding my decision to purchase the stock.

Health Canada's MMPR licensing process is very extensive with much focus on the security of the facility as well as the personnel of the company. Cen Biotech elected to go a step further by applying for its license to build prior to beginning construction of the facility. Additionally, Cen Biotech applied for an import / export license, decided to enhance the property security measures and provided Health Canada with a comprehensive 900 page application. My understanding is that the typical application size at the time was half the size. All of these steps solidified my decision to invest.

A company applying to become a license producer in Canada cannot have executives and staff with a criminal record. Although Cen Biotech has convincingly cleared that requirement, the company and its President have been separately investigated by FINRA, the SEC, OSC, Health Canada, and RCMP multiple times. I do not know of any other company that has been scrutinized to this level, especially when no adverse evidence has surfaced.

Since the announcement to enter the Cannabis industry in 2013 up until the completion and inspection of the facility, both the media and the town of Lakeshore publically supported the company. This again influenced my decision to invest. Shortly after the facility inspection and the report review was conducted in August 2014, it appears that a media campaign was initiated to discredit Cen Biotech. Many articles contained distorted facts about the company, dramatized issues, misinformation and even completely misrepresented facts regarding various subject matters. Investors that

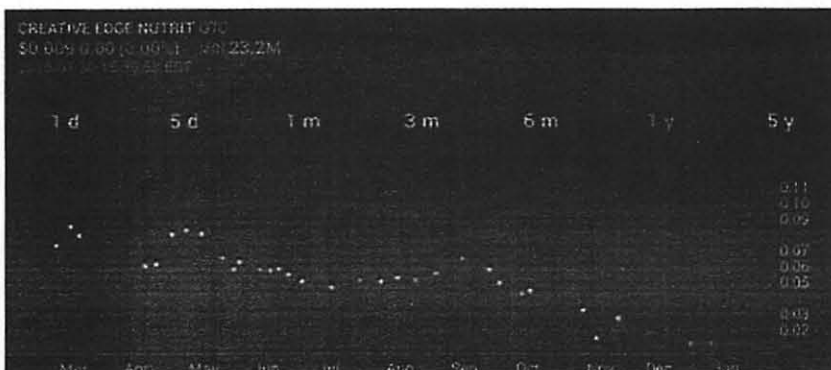

If one were to study the frequency and timing of these defamatory articles, one would find that each article is strategically timed, or timed in succession with other articles to inhibit, stall, and reverse natural share price increases.

Here you will see white dots representing PR's or positive events from the company. The colored dots represent articles released by Grant and associates at key points to drive stock price down. This chart has not been updated since the end of Jan. But the onslaught has continued.

It has come to my attention that the OSC is currently looking into CEN Biotech. While I respect your duty to investigate any circumstances that may seem warranted; I'd like to take this opportunity to bring to your attention the one-sided approach some media outlets and specifically author Grant Robertson has taken.

Since December 20th 2014, Grant Robertson has published 13 articles, equivalent to 1 every week. That seems like an unusually high amount and these articles have had a detrimental effect on the share price. While I respect the freedom of the press, this seems to be a little extreme and possibly a coordinated attack to negatively impact the company and its shareholders. 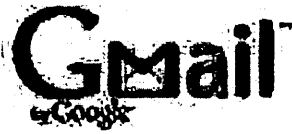

Dear Administrator in Charge of Investigation,

I am writing to you to express my concerns regarding the manipulations and deceits conducted against Cen Bio (under the symbol FITX). But first, let me add some background. I am not a gambler, nor am I a person who has ever spent extravagantly on anything. Barring some stroke of luck I will probably need to work until I die to support my family, and I am fine with that (I have 3 children, two adopted, that all have some special needs).

However, after years of convincing, my wife agreed to let me invest some money in stocks outside of our modest retirement fund. I spent many long months before I decided on a sector, and picked a few stocks, in which I could feel comfortable investing. I found FITX based on long hours of due diligence, research, and serious inquiry.

One of the things that convinced me to invest in FITX was the welcome that was given by the Mayor of Lakeshore and the seriousness with which Cen Bio took the rules of Health Canada's requirements. I was further convinced by Health Canada's eagerness to get Cen Bio producing and the problems that other companies were going through. I also watched as Cen Bio built what appeared to be a state-of-the-art facility, although Cen Bio was careful to post only pictures that were allowed by Health Canada. So, I added more money to my investment.

The first inkling of trouble came when bloggers began stating online that Cen Bio was not properly zoned, and that Lakeshore had problems with the facility. The craziness of these statements did not bother me because I saw the video of the mayor welcoming the company to the town, and I could see (via online images) the building being constructed, which could only happen in Canada with the proper permits. To Whom it May Concern:

My husband and I are shareholders of FITX stock.

We believe the CEO of Cen Biotech, Inc. has been open and transparent in his endeavors to build a medical marijuana facility at the request of Health Canada as a means to provide a product of medicinal value to patients in need.

We also believe the Globe and Mail, Grant Robertson, Matt Finston, and a certain spokesperson from Health Canada, along with others have worked both apart and together to discredit the company and manipulate its stock value.

My husband and I invested in FITX right after CEN Biotech received their "ready to build" letter from Health Canada. Shortly afterward, the Company was encouraged by the government branch to build it faster due to patient demand.

Health Canada (not complying with their own guidelines) came out several months later to inspect the property. Their written inspection showed two minor adjustments that needed to be made. These were made, but it was months and months before the Company received any word from Health Canada.

In the meantime, other facilities reportedly received a license from Health Canada (even though some did not meet all the same requirements that CEN Biotech had met at the time).

Health Canada had advised all municipalities to establish whatever by-laws they needed concerning medical marijuana facilities prior to letting them in to the communities. The Town of Lakeshore chose not to do this prior to embracing CEN Biotech to come and build.

The CEN Biotech facility was completed and passed all inspections in compliance with the Town of Lakeshore's by-laws that were in place throughout all construction. It wasn't until after the neighbors hired an attorney (right at the time of local elections), that the Town of Lakeshore attempted to change its by-laws to re-zone the CEN Biotech facility from its prior classification of agricultural to that of an industrial status. does not fall under the watch of any financial regulator.

But Ontario's refusal to sign on creates a "safe haven" for OTC companies, he added. "Maybe the word is out that Ontario is open season because it's the only province that doesn't have 51-105. It's possible."

But then yesterday, March 25 2015, he reports that the OSC is investigating CEN Biotech:

"CEN Biotech, a company that soared to be worth hundreds of millions of dollars last year on claims that it was being licensed to build the world's largest medical marijuana facility in Canada, is under investigation by the Ontario Securities Commission.

The regulator said Wednesday it is looking into the company and its parent firm, but did not provide further details, such as how long the investigation has been going on or if regulators in the United States are involved.

"The OSC has an active investigation into this matter," Carolyn Shaw-Rimington, spokeswoman for the OSC, said in an e-mail to The Globe and Mail."

There have been accusations thrown at them, but no one has ever been able to definitively prove that their sales were done illegally. That being said, I still don't understand where the OSC has any jurisdiction over this matter. Hopefully someone can clarify that for me.

I am a shareholder of Creative Edge Nutrition (OTC PINK:FITX). Over the past sixteen (16) months I have watched Creative Edge grow and transform under the guidance of the CEO, Bill Chaaban. I have invested and believe in this company because of the product and treatments the company could offer to the Canadian Medical Marijuana Patients under the MMPR regulations. It has been very exciting time over the last year as big strides have been made in the Medical and Research aspects of Marijuana in Canada and abroad (USA). I believe that Bill Chaaban is a pioneer in this field and will play a vital role in leading CEN Bio Inc (subsidiary of Creative Edge) to becoming a global leader in this new industry.

I have had the opportunity to follow all the ups and downs the company has had in the last year. From the announcement of the "Ready to Build Letter" by Health Canada for the Lakeshore Facility in Ontario, to the issuance of a "Denial Letter" on the behalf of Health Canada this past month. I was very happy to see Mayor of Lakeshore, Tom Bain welcome Mr. Chaaban and the Creative Edge Team to Lakeshore at the end of 2013. All of this information can be found on the internet with the daily 10 dozen derogatory postings on IHUB message board, at least 39 negative Articles written by Matt Finston on Seeking Alpha over last 9 months, at least 14 misleading articles by Grant Robertson from Globe and Mail, numerous damaging articles written by Chris Parry Blogger at Stockhouse, constant derogatory rants by Wolf of Weed Street on Twitter, Alan's Bronchtein's and Green Rush Investors Facebook Page daily "bashing", Pump and Dump's website warning of FITX being a Scam, and Yahoo Message Boards. I believe these people along with numerous competitors are worried about the success of CEN Bio along with FITX and are doing everything in their power to cause investors to question the values and/or morals of Bill Chaaban and hoping to derail the success and future of Creative Edge Nutrition and CEN Bio Inc.

To whom it may concern;

I have been an investor in Creative Edge Nutrition (FITX) for about a year now. The reason I invested in the company is because the Ontario Windsor Essex growth and development Council had a press conference with Mayor Bain of Lakeshore, Sandra Pupatello and the company Cen Biotech a subsidiary of Creative edge Nutrition, led by the president and CEO, Bill Chaaban to introduce the company had received ready to build letter from health Canada to grow and sell medical marijuana. "Ready to build" from Heath Canada means that the company and its employees have passed rigorous steps and background checks to go ahead and start the building phase of their 12 million dollar state of the art facility to produce Medical Marijuana for the patient in Canada. It's my understanding that the company is being investigated by the OSC because of information or I believe mis-information reported from a Canadian newspaper the Globe and Mail for reasons only they could know.

In my opinion you're investigating the wrong people. The people you should be investigating are the leaders of Heath Canada, The council and Mayor of the city of Lakeshore, and the newspaper outlet the Globe and Mail.

Let's start with Health Canada. The Application process states that if you follow and pass all the steps of the application and the inspection you will receive your license. The company did in fact complete their building phase and inspection with two minor deficiencies that were addressed immediately. Even the inspector said that this company should receive their license and that it should have been received two weeks after the inspection. Seven months later still no license, it seems that Health Canada has cut all ties with the company in the last step of licensing and that step is The issuance of a license.
